

# WINTER WORLD MASTERS GAMES 2020

## Media Coverage Agreement

Dear Media and Press Partners,

In consideration of being granted credentials to access the Winter World Masters Games (WWMG) 2020 the executing entity innsbruck-tirol sports GmbH (“ITS”) and individual (collectively, “you” the latter “Bearer”) hereby enter into the following Media Coverage Agreement with WWMG 2020.

WWMG 2020 will provide credential(s) necessary for Bearer to gain access to media areas at the Event for the sole and exclusive purpose of editorial event coverage. Time, area and scope of access will be at the sole discretion of WWMG 2020 and/or ITS. Credential(s) and access may be revoked at any time by WWMG 2020 and/or ITS with or without cause, and WWMG 2020 and/or ITS shall have no liability to you whatsoever should WWMG 2020 and/or ITS revoke such access.

Bearer agrees not to attempt to gain access to any area other than those designated for media and to which Bearer has expressly been granted access. Bearer agrees to confine work relating to interviews, video or still photography solely to those locations within designated media areas for which Bearer has been specifically assigned for that work.

This credential is non-transferable. Bearer agrees not to sell, donate or provide it to anyone before or during its use at the Event.

WWMG 2020 requires the Bearer to review and accept the following terms, which have been established in order to ensure the best possible working conditions for everyone involved and the highest possible level of security.

Failure to adhere to the house rules and the individual provisions contained within them may lead to the Bearer being banned from the event and/or asked to leave the event premises. It may also result in civil or criminal proceedings.

### Media Rules – General

✓ Accredited media must:

1. Be a minimum 18 years of age.
2. Be in good mental and physical condition.
3. Have appropriate insurance coverage, in particular health and accident insurance.
4. Observe the house rules and applicable legal provisions at all times.
5. Acknowledge that they are responsible for themselves, their own safety and the safety of their possessions at the Event. This principle applies regardless of any instructions and permission given by

security staff.

6. Not jeopardize the safety of other persons through negligent actions which could be avoided (e.g. items left lying in areas people walk through).

7. Wear accreditation visibly at all times and show accreditation at checkpoints.

8. Not use drones in, above or close to the event venue.

9. Follow instructions given by private security staff, the police, WWMG 2020 and ITS staff, course marshals and volunteers in order to maintain security at all times. Failure to follow instructions will result in the Bearer being asked to leave the Event and may result in the loss of accreditation.

## Media Coverage Agreement

I hereby confirm that I have read and understood the provisions and information set out in the 2020 Media Coverage Agreement and agree to accept and comply with them. Furthermore, I confirm that:

- I shall take responsibility for my own actions and ensure the safety and security of all persons involved. In particular I shall not hinder the running of any WWMG 2020 competition, or endanger athletes, by entering restricted areas.
- I have appropriate insurance coverage, in particular health and accident insurance.

### Liability

- I release the organiser from liability for any damage, providing this damage is not the result of gross negligence or wilful intent. The organiser shall not be held liable for pure financial losses, loss of earnings or indirect damage.
- The amount of any liability of the organiser for damage (except that resulting from gross negligence or wilful intent) shall be limited to a maximum of the sum insured under the third-party liability insurance of the organiser.
- For all accredited persons who do not pay to receive accreditation, the limitation of liability set out above shall also apply to personal injury if this is the result of only slight negligence.
- I am aware that the organiser does not assume liability for damage caused by other participants to me or by me to other participants. I am aware that the organiser will not take out insurance for me.
- I agree to hold the organiser harmless from all claims relating to damage caused by me.

### Additional information

- Any disputes resulting from my participation in an event of the WWMG 2020 shall be resolved under Austrian law, with the exception of the Austrian reference norms.
  - The place of jurisdiction shall be the competent court in Innsbruck, Austria.
- Should individually provisions of this declaration be declared to be partly or fully void or unexecutable, this shall have no impact on the legal validity of the remaining provisions in this declaration of liability.
