Olympic spirit for everyone

From 10th to 19th of January 2020, Innsbruck will be hosting the third [Winter World Masters Games](#) after Bled (2010) and Quebec (2015). The WWMG 2020 offer amateur sports enthusiasts aged 30+ the unique opportunity to take part in an international sporting event. More than 3,100 athletes from over 58 nations will gather in Innsbruck to compete for medals in [12 disciplines](#) according to the motto "spirit together". The sports programme consists of: Alpine Skiing, Ski Mountaineering, Curling, Ice Hockey, Figure Skating, Speed Skating, Short Track, Biathlon, Cross-Country Skiing, Nordic Combined, Ski Jumping and Ski Orienteering. Promoting the "sport for all" philosophy and the Olympic values, they will strive to perform their personal best in respect and friendship between each other. The competitions will be organised in close cooperation with experienced sports organisers and will take place in the [seven WWMG 2020 venues](#).

Masters Village: Rock, Superhits and more on the big stage

Located in Maria-Theresien-Straße, Innsbruck's main shopping street in the centre of the city, the [Masters Village](#) will be the cultural heart of the WWMG 2020. The traditional winter market including attractions and concerts will be open daily between 11th and 19th of January from 11:30am until 10pm. After a long day of sporting action, everyone will gather here to celebrate together. The Masters Village will also host selected victory ceremonies in the evenings (every day from 6pm). Athletes, guests and locals are all invited to take part in the WWMG 2020 cultural events. **Entry is free!**

On 15th of January "[Erwin & Edwin](#)", the coolest electro-bass combination of Austria, will heat up the Masters Village. Another highlight will follow on 18th of January: "[Josh](#)", known for the summer hit "Cordula Grün", will create a great atmosphere with its Viennese sound. From Silent Disco DJ Battle, presented by Audioversum, to finest Rock, in cooperation with the Hard Rock Café, much more awaits you.

Opening Ceremony

On 11th of January the Masters Games 2020 will be ceremonially opened in the heart of the city of Innsbruck. The athletes' parade will be the first highlight: from the city centre to Masters Village. Right there the official start will be announced. Immediately afterwards "[Matakustix](#)" will rock the evening on the big stage with a mix of beatbox and folk music. Free entry!

The hundreds of volunteers, without whom none of the events organised by [innsbruck-tirol sports GmbH](#) would be possible, are of course also involved in the WWMG 2020. Almost 700 volunteers have already registered and will actively support the organisation of world's biggest winter sports festival for 30+ year olds. Host City Innsbruck

Innsbruck is located in the heart of the Alps and boasts a unique charm. The narrow medieval streets in the oldtown are set against a stunning alpine backdrop. Highlights in the city centre include the Golden Roof, Innsbruck's most famous attraction, and the Imperial Palace. As well as being a popular tourist destination, Innsbruck also boasts a rich sporting tradition. It has played host to Olympic Games on three occasions – a record.
